Commercial aircraft	Any Bush STOL aircraft



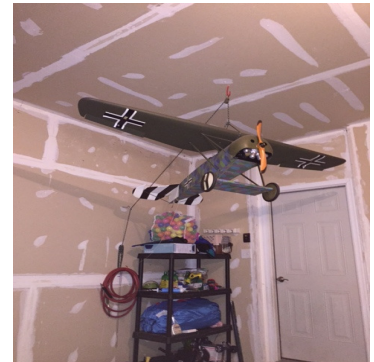
