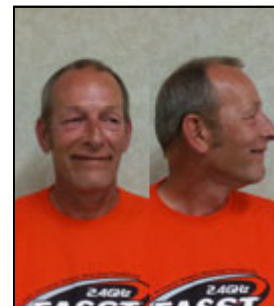
**Meeting Minutes - July**
